I had my first appraisal meeting to set my goals for the year with the BOT Chair and the independant consultant we use. The discussion was robust and I have chosen to explore the aspect of our Vision statement that says "Inspiring minds"

- What are we doing to meet this aspirational goal?
- How do we know that we are inspiring minds?
- What are we doing well with curriculum and what can we improve?

It is essential to me that we are all aiming high to be the best we can be at Rakaia. I will be conducting some research and surveys to see what you think. I will look at other schools and countries that adjust their curriculum and lessons to get the very best from their pupils.

We have spent some time looking carefully at how we can get the best from your children. Our approach to curriculum uses these big ideas and we spend a term on each before meeting it again in another context.

- **Energy:** Identify energy sources and their impacts.
- **Culture and Community:** exploration of cultures and communities within the school, Rakaia and the world.
- **Innovation and Discovery:** the creation and design of a new or existing method, idea or product through inquiry.
- **Change:** the act or process through which something becomes different.
- **Relationships :** developing skills that the students can use when relating to others in a variety of situations.
- **Communication :** developing skills that will enable students to communicate confidently using a range of tools.

So please consider what it is you want for your children at Rakaia. We are beginning to pull together a new Strategic Plan for the school and meetings will be held and we will invite you to

come and share your ideas and your voice so we can say our curriculum is owned by our parents. Please watch this space!

This free programme takes you from a learner to a licenced driver, matches you with a volunteer driving mentor and supports you along the way.

The programme is open to migrant women living on farms in the Ashburton District.
